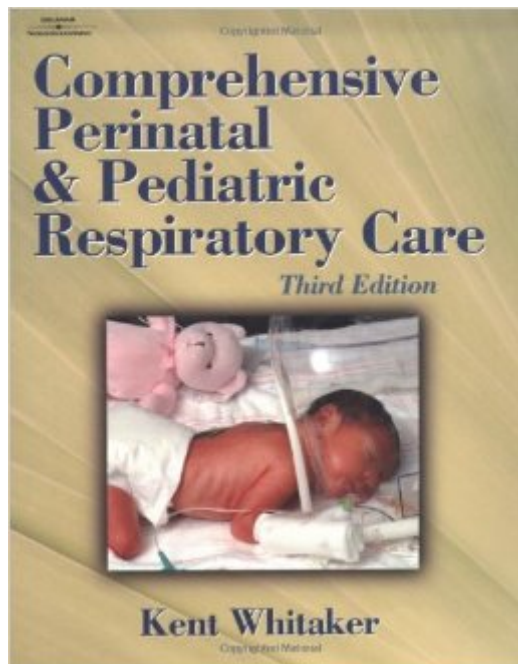

Excellent content, but so many typos for a third edition! There are Posttest questions at the end of each chapter, which provide a good review. Some answers are obscure and I've had to reread portions several times for the answer. There are other questions that don't have a right answer listed.

The book is packed with writing and underlining from the previous owner that it's sometimes hard to read and very distracting, but it does the job and definitely beats spending that enormous amount of money for the used version in school.

This book is way overdue for an update. The description of disease states is still accurate, but treatment information is very old and doesn't reflect changes in the last 10-15 years. Also, there are tons of typos throughout the book (example: the chapter eleven questions are cut off, as if they left out a page or two.) It's easy enough to read, and the price is right because it has been around for so long, but a newer book with up-to-date info would be worth the money.
