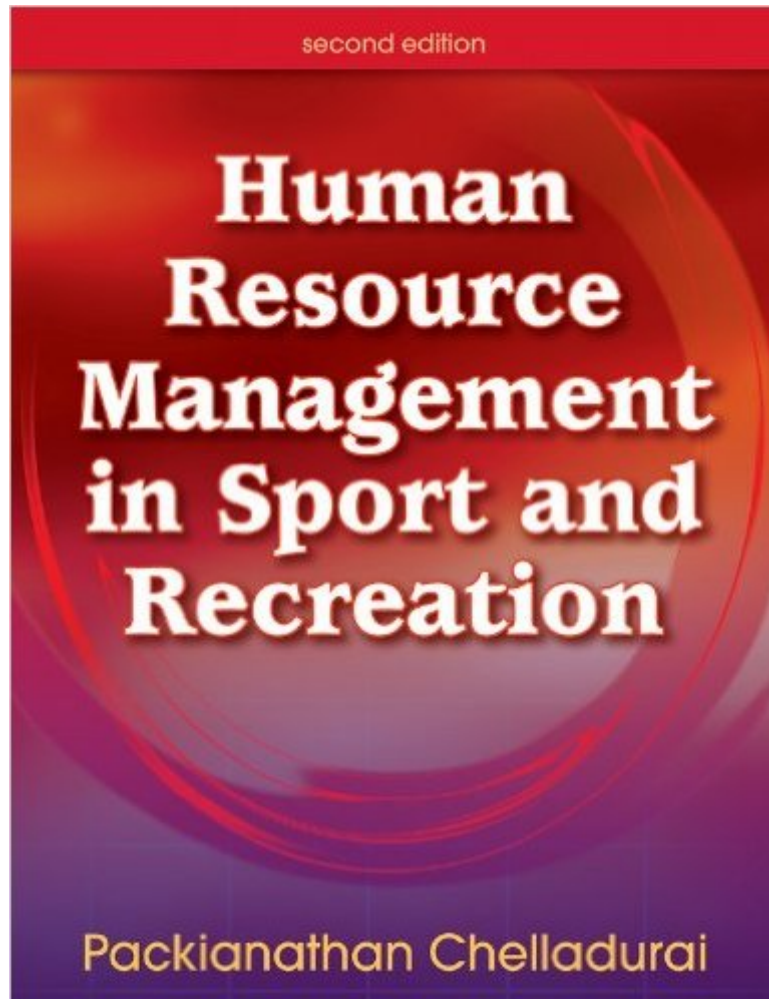

Part II focuses on differences among people and how the differences affect behavior in sport and recreation organizations. This part covers human resource issues related to abilities, personality, values, and motivation among the three sets. Part III explores significant organizational processes in the management of human resources. Included are chapters on organizational justice, job design, staffing and career considerations, leadership, performance appraisal, reward systems, and internal marketing. Finally, part IV discusses two significant outcomes expected of human resource practices: satisfaction and commitment. *Human Resource Management in Sport and Recreation, Second Edition*, will guide students' understanding of key concepts in human resources in the sport and recreation

industry. In doing so, it will prepare them for a career in that industry.v
