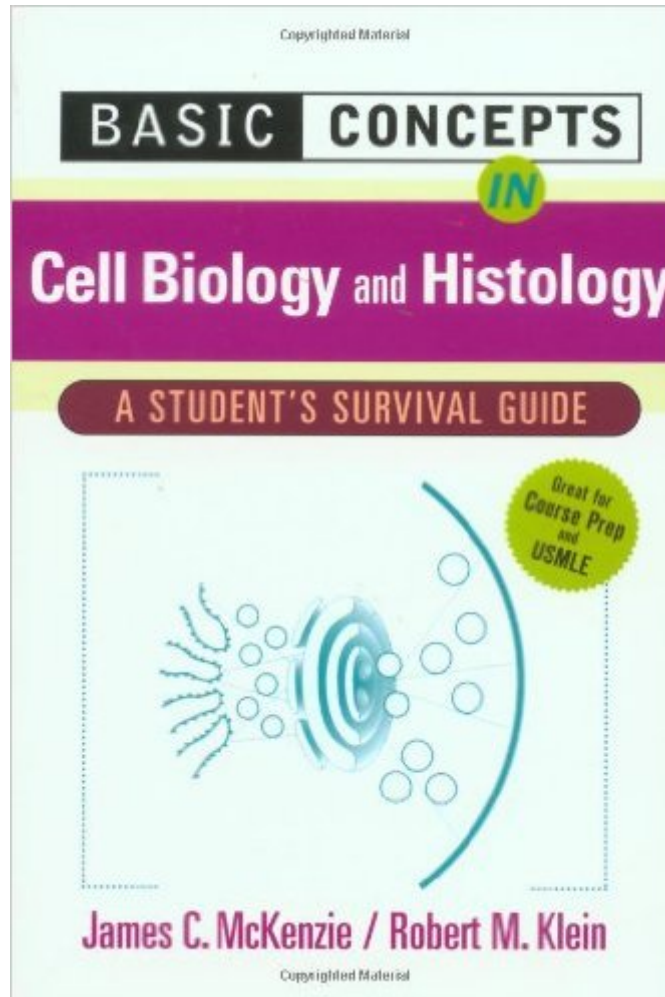


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Basic Concepts In Cell Biology: A Student's Survival Guide
